Hacking the Learning Curve

Bronkar Lee

Bronkar is a peak performance expert, author, internationally acclaimed performer, entertainment producer, and keynote speaker. Bronkar has always been fascinated by learning, as both an enthusiastic student and insightful teacher. A sampling of credits includes touring Europe as ringmaster to a world-renowned circus, teaching at-risk youth to develop the confidence to overcome abuse and addiction, and appearing with Jay Leno on the Tonight Show.

As a peak performance coach, Bronkar has helped clients to achieve personal breakthroughs and accomplish goals for health, success, and well-being. His one-man variety show continues to be in great demand – everywhere from Disney cruise ships to corporate conferences for Google and Facebook to half-time shows at Madison Square Garden. MRI Safety - How To Make A Meaningful Impact On Your MRI Safety Practices from an MR Safety Officer and MR Safety Expert

William Faulkner, Jr. B.S., R.T.(R)(MR)(CT), FSMRT, MRSO(MRSC)

Bill Faulkner is currently working as an independent consultant through his own company, William Faulkner & Associates, providing MRI and CT education as well as MRI safety and clinical operations consulting for 19 years. His clients include health care facilities, and medical companies such as GE, Philips, Siemens, Aspect Imaging, Invivo, Medtronic, Bracco Diagnostics and Metrasens. He has been teaching and lecturing on MRI in for over 25 years.

He is an active member and Fellow of the SMRT; serving as the first president. He is a founding board member of the American Board of Magnetic Resonance Safety (ABMRS) and is a credentialed MR Safety Officer. Bill is the author of "Rad Techs Guide to MRI: Basic Physics, Instrumentation and Quality Control". He is the co-author of "Review Questions for MRI", and a contributing author for "MRI for Technologists", "Handbook for MRI", and the first edition of "The Physics of Clinical MR Taught Through Images".

Dr. Zachary Friis. Ph.D., DABR, MRSE

Dr. Friis practices diagnostic medical physics, medical nuclear physics, and health physics at West Physics. He came to West Physics from the field of advanced plasma physics. His research encompassed the design of fusion reactors, which utilize extremely powerful magnetic fields to confine plasmas for the purpose of energy production.

During Dr. Friis's tenure at West Physics, he has practiced medical physics in 49 states, 2 US Territories, and internationally. Now he primarily covers clientele in Florida and the Caribbean. Dr. Friis is the primary MRI subject matter expert for West Physics, which encompasses all aspects of MR Safety. Dr. Friis is board certified by the American Board of Radiology and the American Board of Magnetic Resonance Safety as a credentialed MR Safety Expert. Dr. Friis is originally from Valdosta, Georgia.


Come prepared for a spectacular evening of wonderful food, open bars, live music and dancing in this enchanting setting.
